"AND THE METZORAH SHALL CALL OUT: UNCLEAN, UNCLEAN." (Vayikra 13:45)

One of our sages wrote that this verse can be read as, "Unclean," the unclean person thinks everyone else is unclean. That is, a person who finds fault with others is at his core projecting his own faults and imperfections on them. As the Rabbis have said, "Those who try to invalidate others do so with their own blemishes."

One way to discover your faults and blemishes is to see what weaknesses you notice in people. If I focus on specific on negative aspects of others, it is possible that I have that tendency myself.

For this week let us try to realize what aspects of other people we find difficult or bothersome and utilize it as an opportunity to look inward and correct that weakness inside first.
