HALACHIC INSIGHT

In situations where it is impossible to select food, one is permitted to remove the waste and leave the food behind. It is this rule which permits one to peel fruits and vegetables on shabbos. Even though I i'm separating the peel from the food. since it is impossible to gain access to the food otherwise, removing the peel is not considered an act of selecting, but a routine manner of eating. However, foods may be peeled only for immediate use, and a specialized instrument like a vegetable peeler may not be used. The same holds true for eggs or nuts, which may be shelled for immediate consumption. The use of a nutcracker is permitted. Similarly, when needed for immediate use, one may remove the spoiled outer leaves of a head of lettuce, to expose the fresh ones. Another application is with a cantaloupe. One may scoop out the pits from its cavity since there is no way to remove the food, separating the waste is permitted for immediate use.
