The Baal Shem Tov explained that the descendants of Avraham are like stars. We know there are 100 billion stars in our galaxy. We have never reached close to those numbers. What did Hashem mean?

We see the stars from a great distance and they appear to be a tiny speck in the sky but in the heavens they are gigantic. So, too, in this world many people look very small. Many people feel very small, but in reality every person has a neshama, a soul and has unlimited potential and abilities. Every person has greatness within him.

When you look at another person realize that he is a star. He might seem small to you and might appear to have not accomplished very much. Gain an awareness of the great potential of each person. View each person as an entire world, as an enormous being in the cosmos. When you see people in this light you will behave towards them with great respect. When you show others respect they will gain greater respect for themselves. This can give a person the encouragement he needs to live up to his potential greatness.

This attitude is not just towards others but it is towards myself also. Every one of us is a star. Every one of us is bigger than the sun. I matter, and in the heavens Hashem sees me for the tremendous person I can become. When I realize the greatness within myself I will make different choices and live life on a different plane.

The Chidushei Harim who was the Rebbe of Gur called in his grandson the Sefas Emes to let him know that he will be taking over the Hassidus. The Sefas Emes was only 19 years old at the time. He looked at his grandfather and told him, you are so great, so righteous how could I be worthy of such a position? His grandfather explained that there was once a mountain climber who went through Europe climbing the highest mountains. There was one mountain that took him over a week of painstaking effort for every step he made. When he got the top of the mountain he saw a child who came to greet him. "How did you get up here?" the climber asked the child? "I was born here", answered the child.

For this week, take out a moment every day to contemplate the greatness that lies within ourselves. This will allow us to strive for greater purpose and meaning in our lives!

HALACHIC INSIGHT

One of the avos melachos with many applications in the kitchen is kneading (lisha). Kneading is defined as binding together small particles like flour, by means of a binding agent like water to form one mass. The melacha of kneading also applies to kneading non food items such as clay; however our discussion will center on foods.

The primary example of the melacha is kneading flour with water to form a dough. Other applications of this prohibition are mixing baby cereal with milk to form a mass, and mixing eggs or tuna with oil to form egg salad or tuna salad. Another example can be making instant oatmeal with the water and the oatmeal creating a mass. There can also be other problems like bishul when making oatmeal.

This issur is not limited to kneading, but also forbids any similar activity which unites small particles into a body. Thus, stirring or beating food particles into one body with an added liquid is also assur.
