"AND PHARAOH SENT AND HE CALLED YOSEF, AND THEY RAN
WITH HIM FROM THE PRISON." (Bereishis 41:14)



The Chafetz Chaim takes note that when the time came for Yosef's liberation, he wasn't let out of prison slowly. Rather he was rushed out of his captivity with the greatest speed. This is the way Hashem brings about redemption. The moment it is the proper time not even one second is lost. This is how it will be with the final redemption, said the Chafetz Chaim. As soon as the right time comes we will immediately be delivered from our exile.

In every difficult life situation realize in just one moment the entire picture can change. Yosef had no deadline by which he could count on being set free.

His imprisonment and freedom were not dependent on the whims of his mortal captors. Rather, Hashem gave him a set time to remain in prison. As soon as the time was reached Yosef was immediately saved from his plight. This awareness can give you encouragement in difficult times.

Even in those situations where you can make no change for improvement and you do not see the situation changing in the future, your liberation can still come in the next moment.

That is Chanukah. The Jews seemed to be lost. The odds were impossible and when the Maccabees made their effort to stay strong in what they believed in, the miraculous happened and salvation came.

HALACHA

Milk cartons: Opening the spout of a milk or orange juice carton violates the prohibition of koreayah, tearing and asiyas hapesach; fashioning an opening.

It is permissible, however, to puncture the bottom of the container, rendering it unfit for further use, and to open the spout afterward, to pour the contents into another vessel.

Bottle caps which lift off or screw off without breaking may be removed on shabbos. Those which break when unscrewed may not be opened, as this violates the prohibition of makeh betapatish; completing the formation of a utensil.

One who needs to open such a container should first puncture the cap without cutting any printed words.

The punctured cap may then be unscrewed since it is no longer fit for use and cannot be considered a "completed utensil".

Opening sealed boxes, violates the issur of koreya, tearing and asiyas hapesach forming an opening.

One is permitted to tear or cut open the box (without tearing any printed words or pictures) only in a manner which damages the package.
