Rashi says Yehuda rose up through two actions. First, he was responsible for the selling of Yosef instead of killing him. Second, he saved Tamar through publicly embarrassing himself.

The Kuzari states that someone who rules over himself and his impulses is the definition of a righteous person. Such a person is a true ruler and will be able to lead others with the same integrity that he rules over himself. This is why Yehuda merited being the ruler and having all future kings come from his tribe.

You can see the tremendous outcomes of ruling over yourself. A person who exudes inner strength and self-confidence draws people to choose him as their leader.

When Yehuda admitted publicly what he did and embarrassed himself to save Tamar it took tremendous self-discipline and that ability to rule over himself made him a true king.

For this week when something comes up that I need to apologize for and it is difficult to admit the wrong that was done, realize when I admit the mistake to someone else I am becoming a true leader.

## **HALACHA**

There is an obligation to light candles for Shabbos on Friday in every Jewish home. Most mefarshim hold it is a Rabbinic origin.

Shabbos candles must be lit specifically for the sake of shabbos. If they were lit for some other purpose without shabbos in mind one cannot fulfill the mitzvah of the shabbos candles with them. They must be extinguished and relit specifically for Shabbos.

There are 3 reasons given for shabbos candles: Honoring Shabbos, Oneg Shabbos, and Shalom Bayis. The celebration of Shabbos is a cornerstone of Jewsih faith, and as such it is only fitting that Shabbos be treated as an honored occasion. For this reason, our chachamim said candles should be lit to brighten the Shabbos meal. Lighting candles is therefore a fulfillment of the mitzvah of Kavod shabbos, honoring Shabbos.
