ENTREAT HASHEM THAT THERE BE NO MORE MIGHTY THUNDERINGS AND HAIL; AND I WILL LET YOU GO, AND YOU SHALL STAY NO LONGER. (Shemos 9:28)



Rabbi Yeruchem Levovitz commented that Pharaoh did not mean to lie when he said he will let the Jews go free. He truly meant it and was not mocking Moshe. The intensity of the plague caused him to truly change. Right after though he reverted back to himself and did not feel the statement he made about freeing the Jews was binding.

This is a general habit of people. When a person is in the midst of difficulty and hardship his ideals can become very high and he truly wants to achieve them. As soon as the situation becomes better though he reverts back to his old self and it is hard to believe it was the same person.

When a person finds himself in a difficult situation and wants to truly change for the better, remember those promises and resolutions when the situation becomes better. 



HALACHA

The Zohar writes that women must light the Shabbos candles with heartfelt joy and enthusiasm, for this mitzvah is a supreme honor for her and a way for her to earn G-d fearing sons who will illuminate the world with their Torah and fear of Heaven. Through this mitzvah, she also causes her husband to merit a long life. She should therefore be particularly meticulous in the performance of the mitzvah.

If possible, the woman should be dressed in her Shabbos clothing when she lights the candles. However, if she is running late, it is preferable that she light the candles in her weekday clothing rather than don her Shabbos clothes and risk desecrating the Shabbos by lighting too late chas ve'shalom.

It is customary for women to give some tzedakah before lighting the candles.
