HALACHA

One of the nissim that Hashem performed for Klal Yisrael in the midbar for forty years was giving them maan every day. On Friday they received an extra portion for Shabbos. To commemorate that we have two loaves of bread called lechem mishna. This chiyuv is rabbinic.

All men, women and children who are old enough to be trained are obligated to begin the meal with lechem mishna. When one person makes the beracha it suffices for everyone at the table. The challos should be made in the shape of the letter vav, because two times vav which is 6 is equal to twelve which is the number of lechem hapanim on the shulchan in the Bais Hamikdash. In addition the minhag is to have a six braid on each challah to also equal the twelve lechem hapanim of the shulchan.

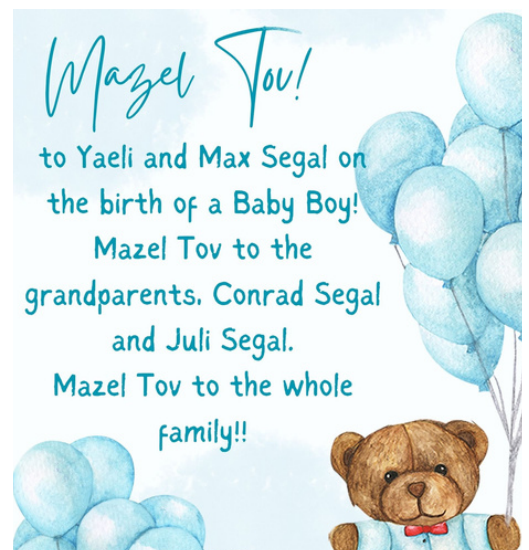
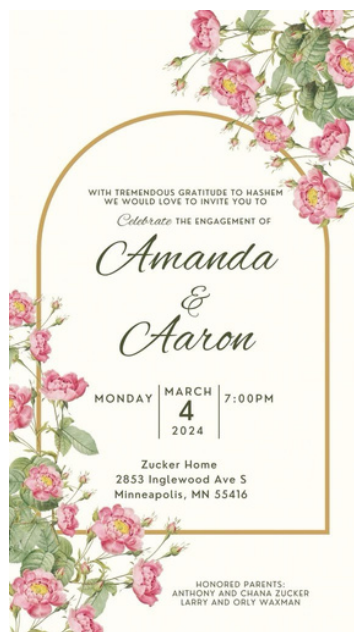
KIDDUSH
