

Have a powerful Shabbos!



# **HALACHA**

The listener during kiddush must be silent and attentive and make every effort to hear each word. The listener may not speak during kiddush. If he did the rules are as follows:

- 1. If he spoke during Vayechulu and he missed some words, he still has been yotze his kiddush obligation. However, he should repeat Vayachulu during the meal with a cup of wine and drink it.
- 2. If he spoke during the borei prei hagafen he does not need to repeat kiddush but he can't drink the wine unless he repeats the beracha himself.
