One way to discover your faults and blemishes is to see what weaknesses you notice in people. If I focus on the negative aspects of others, it is possible that I have that tendency myself.


For this week let us try to realize what aspects of other people we find difficult or bothersome and utilize it as an opportunity to look inward and correct that weakness inside first.

### HALACHA

One of the many miracles Hashem performed in the desert for Klal Yisrael was the מן.

It came from shamayim every day. On Shabbos it did not fall and a double portion was sent on Friday. As a remembrance of the double portion we begin each Shabbos with the two loaves of challah. They are known as lechem mishna. Most mefarshim learn this is a derabanan mitzvah.

All men, women, and children old enough to be trained in mitzvos are obligated to begin the meal with lechem mishna. When one person makes a berecha over the challah for everyone else, his lechem mishna suffices for them.

The challos should be made in the shape of the letter vav which has the numerical value of six, because two times six is twelve corresponding to the lechem hapanim on the shulchan in the Mishkan. In addition, the two challos are customarily braided with six strands of dough each, to symbolize these twelve lechem hapanim.
