"LOVE YOUR FELLOW MAN AS YOURSELF, I AM HASHEM." (VAYIKRA 19:18)

The Talmud relates that a non-Jew came to Hillel and asked him to convert him on condition that he be taught the whole Torah standing on one foot. Hillel accepted his condition and told him, "What you dislike, do not do to your friend. This is the entire Torah." Since Hillel was referring to the commandment of loving your fellow man why didn't he just quote the verse?

Rabbi Yeruchem Levovitz explained that this teaches us an important lesson about loving your neighbor. From the words "love your fellow man" one might think as long as I feel love towards others I am fulfilling the commandment. In truth feeling love is not sufficient.

The love I feel must motivate me to positive actions for others and refraining from actions or words that can cause pain. The Torah definitely requires us to feel love for others but our behavior towards them must manifest this love. Therefore, Hillel explained to the man the depth of what the commandment meant, to have a profoundly positive feeling for others and behave in an elevated manner in our daily encounters with them.

Be on the lookout for acts of kindness. When a person looks for them he will find them everywhere.

For this week go out of your way to share with someone how much you care about him.

HALACHA

It is permitted to attach an adhesive item to another surface temporarily—meaning for less than 24 hours—and in cases of necessity, up to seven days. However, it is prohibited (assur) to attach it permanently.

Therefore, it is permitted to place a band-aid over a wound on Shabbos, since it is assumed the band-aid will be removed relatively soon. However, care should be taken to attach the band-aid only to the skin, since it will ultimately be separated from there.

One should not fasten a band-aid to another band-aid, as people tend to peel both away from the skin together without separating them first. Similarly, when wrapping a band-aid around a finger, one should not fasten one adhesive end to the other, since the band-aid might later be slipped off without separating the ends—raising a concern of tofer (the melacha of sewing).

Instead, the band-aid should be wrapped around the finger at an angle, so that both adhesive ends attach directly to the skin.

If one mistakenly fastened the two ends of the band-aid together on Shabbos, he should be careful to unfasten them when removing the band-aid.

Likewise, one should not use a band-aid to tape or secure a piece of cloth or gauze on Shabbos. Instead, the bandage should be tied or held in place with tape. When removing it, be sure to separate the tape from the band-aid itself.
