"TAKE FOR ME AN OFFERING." (Shemos 25:2)

Rabbi Yosef Dov Soleveitchik explains that the Torah uses the word take when referring to the donations of the tabernacle even though people were giving the money and not taking the money.

The Torah is teaching us, that only money a person gives away to charity is really his. The money a person has in his possessions is not part of him and is not eternal. He has the use of it when he is in this world but it is not forever. For this reason the Torah uses the term "taking" when it refers to giving to a worthwhile cause, for in this way a person is truly acquiring. The money I give to charity is my eternal possession.

For this week let us go out of our way to give charity to a worthy cause. Give it in the presence of your children, so that they too will understand the true value of money and the good it does for others.

HALACHA

One is forbidden to spray perfume or cologne onto any garment on Shabbos – including a dress, shirt, or suit.

Likewise, it is forbidden to place scented powder or any scented deodorizer into shoes on Shabbos. Spraying a wig with hairspray on Shabbos is generally forbidden because of the melachah of Boneh (building). In addition, spraying a wig with scented hairspray violates the separate prohibition of perfuming.

It is forbidden to spray scented deodorizers onto furniture or carpets on Shabbos.

One is allowed to spray air fresheners into the air on Shabbos.

One is forbidden on Shabbos to dilute flavored mouthwash with water, since doing so imparts a scent to the water.
